

Free Early Learning for 2-year-olds

Eligibility

The Free for 2s offer is for parents of 2-year-olds who:

- work and meet certain income criteria and receive certain benefits
- do not work and receive certain benefits
- live in Haringey

Applying for Free for 2s

Act now – places are limited.

With Haringey's Free for 2s, some 2-year-olds can have a funded early learning and childcare for up to 15 hours a week.

You can apply once your child is 1 year and 6 months old, however, they cannot start until the term after their second birthday. You can apply straight away if you have already missed the term your child could have started.

3- and 4-year-olds Funded Early learning and Childcare

Eligibility

Working parent/carer or parents/ carers who receive additional support, your child can have a funded early learning and childcare at Golden Glitters Nursery for up to 15 hours a week.

You can apply directly to Golden Glitters Nursery; you do not need a letter or a code for this offer.

When can your child start

For children born between	Funding starts from
1 September to 31 December	Spring term – 1 January
1 January to 31 March	Summer term – 1 April
1 April to 31 August	Autumn term – 1 September

Funded early learning and childcare starts the term after the child turns 3 years old and continues until they start in the reception class of their primary school.

Remember to contact us just before or as soon as your child turns 3 because you need to register in readiness for the relevant term, they can start in. Places get taken up quickly.
